

Two shops in Bracknell Town Centre provide the setting for the Bracknell Spring Awakening which takes place on Saturday 8th May 2010.

Unit 12 (next to Boots) in Princess Square and Unit 4 in Charles Square will be taken over for the day by exhibitors who aim to show how Bracknell is adapting to a low-carbon economy. Exhibitions will be staged on the themes of renewable energy, sustainable transport, energy conservation and recycling.

The event is being organised by Bracknell & District Friends of the Earth and Bracknell Regeneration Partnership.

Local traders will also be present selling Fairtrade and recycled goods.
